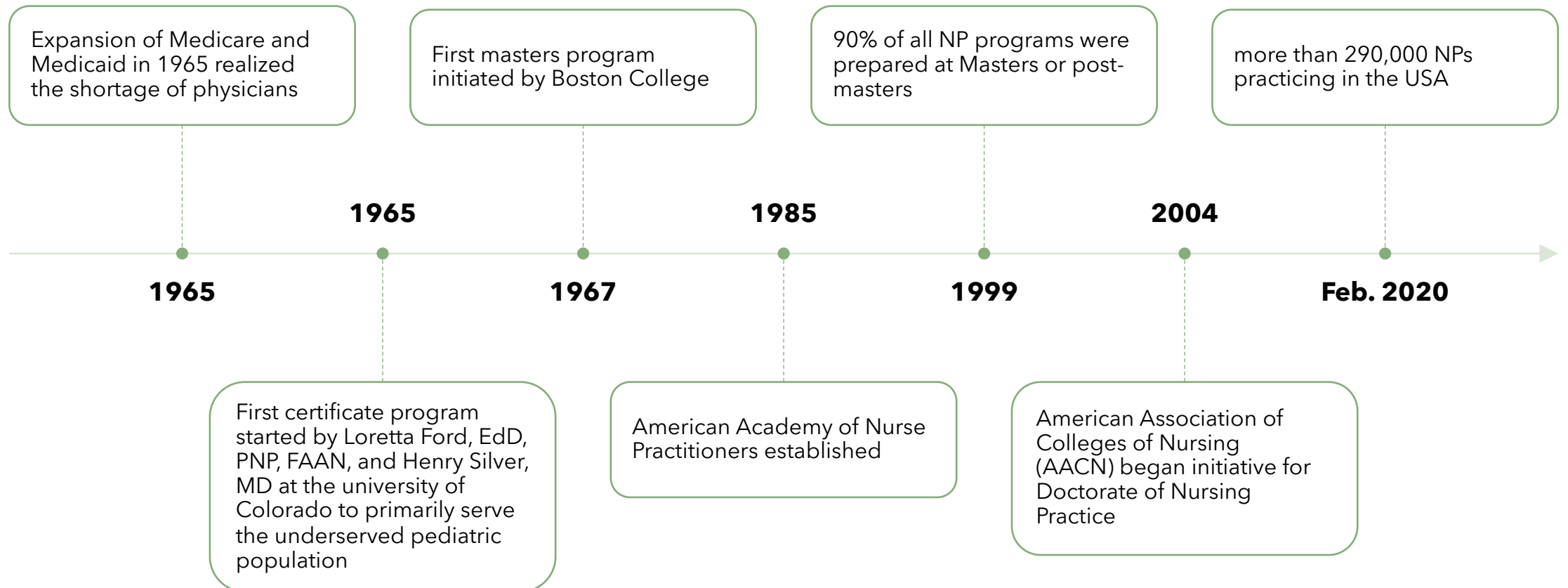

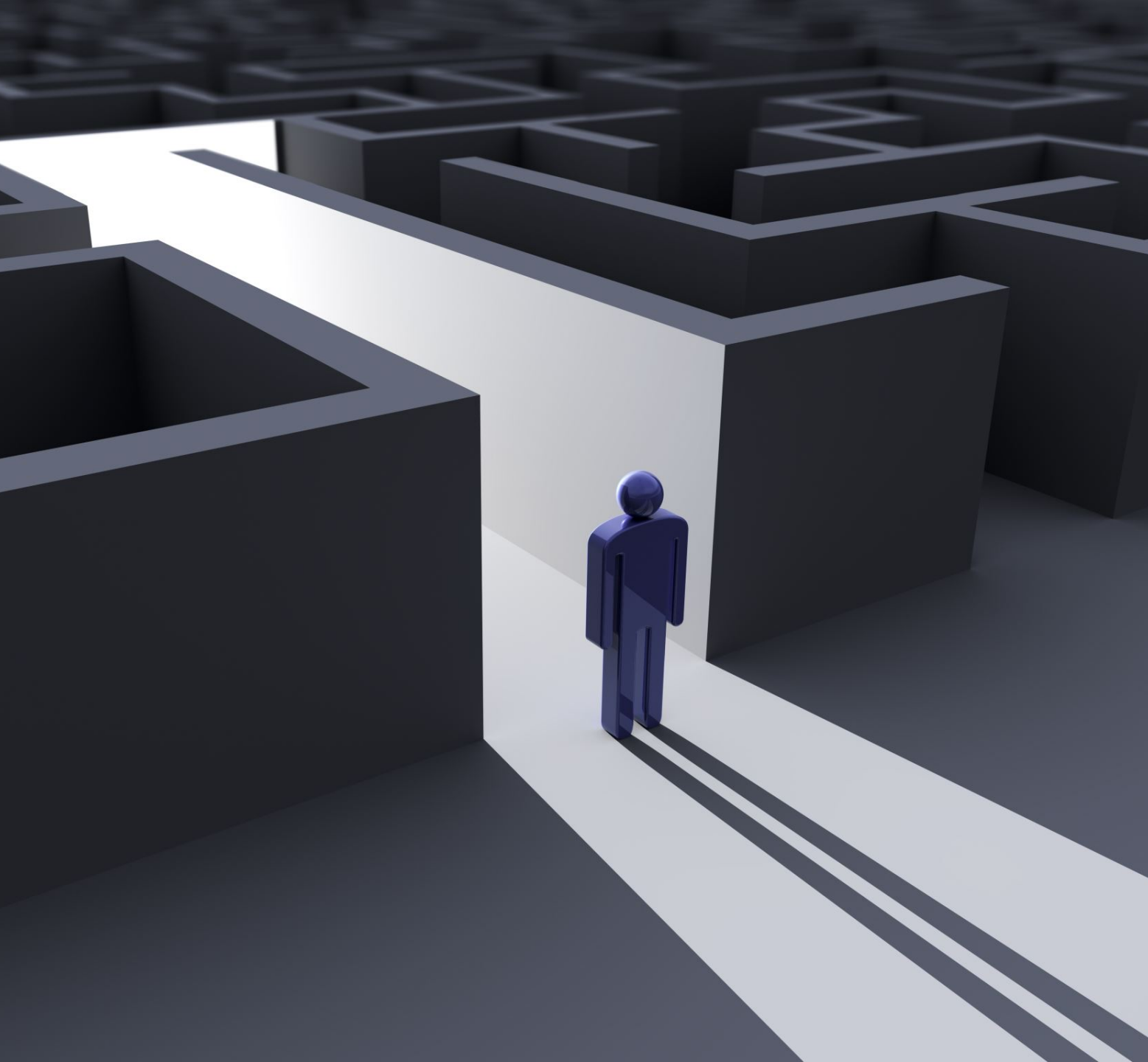

Family Nurse Practitioner

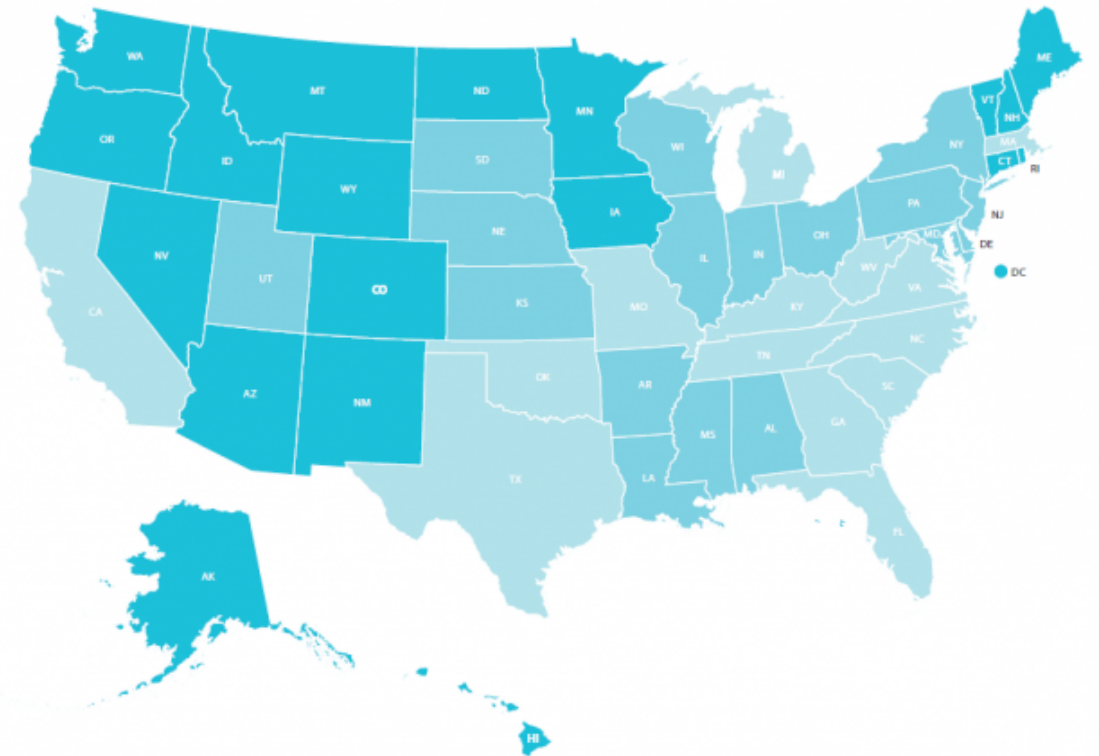
- Birth to end of life



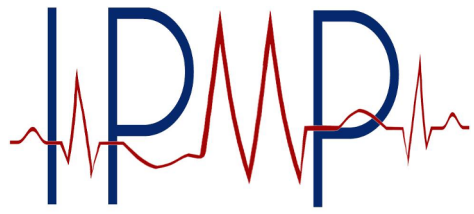
